WITTENBURG, GERMANY — Mühlenchemie recently helped sponsor a cultural event that included a concert from Russian pianist Evgeni Koroliov and a visit to the FlourWorld Museum.

Koroliov gave a concert at St. Bartholomew's church in Wittenburg, Germany, as part of the 25th Musical Festival of Mecklenburg-West Pomerania. The event is Germany's third-largest classical music festival.



Evgeni Koroliov interpreted works of Johann Sebastian Bach and Franz Schubert.


Before and after the concert, the event was celebrated at the FlourWorld Museum with the director of the festival, the artist, and representatives of the international milling family.
